Getting to know each other well

I'm wondering whether my business plan is consistent with my desires:

- what do I want to do / not do?
- what do I like to do / not do?
- what am I capable of doing / unable to do?

Taking stock of your skills

Take stock of his skills and know-how, and his desire to surpass himself:

Throughout my career, what skills and know-how have I acquired? What can I do?

What are my skills and those I will need to succeed in my business project?

What can I not do? What are the skills I need to carry out my business project and how can I acquire or strengthen them?

Realism and motivation

I have to be honest with myself and ask myself what are the things I can't do in relation to the requirements of my project. Is there a contradiction between my resources and my needs?

The aim is to determine whether I am able to continue my project or not.

In some cases, I can only choose to postpone my business creation :

- To give myself time;
- To supplement my financial resources;

- To increase my skills.

Network and support

The support of the entourage is important because the entrepreneurial adventure is often solitary. When a difficulty arises, who will support me? I look around me for people who can help me psychologically, emotionally, professionally or financially.
